



Code of Ethics

The Midwest Association for Toxicology and Therapeutic Drug Monitoring (MATT) expects its members to maintain good moral character, high integrity, good repute, and high ethical and professional standing for continued recognition by the MATT Executive Board, and to conform to the following principles of ethical conduct:

- Conduct themselves with honesty and integrity at all times.
- Perform all professional activities in Toxicology and Therapeutic Drug Monitoring honestly and with professional integrity
- Refrain from knowingly misrepresenting 1) their professional qualifications, 2) education, 3) training, 4) employment history, 5) evidentiary information, and 6) any other material facts.
- Hold in proper confidence all information obtained or received in the course of their professional practice, and to refrain from misuse of any such information.
- Refrain from any action or activity which would tend to bring disrepute upon or otherwise harm the profession of Toxicology, Therapeutic Drug Monitoring or the Midwest Association for Toxicology and Therapeutic Drug Monitoring.
